Participation requires submission of the attached application and adherence to the requirements listed below. This event will also serve as a neighborhood party and fundraiser/membership drive for RPR.

Who may submit?

Amateur and professional artists are encouraged to participate. RPR residents and friends or local residents of Fort Lauderdale, are welcome to submit work. Formal groups and leagues, as well as informal groups and pairs, are welcome to display. A ten by ten foot space will be \$45 and artists need to provide their own display.

What can be displayed?

Work must be appropriate for public of all ages. Violence, drugs, nudity, sexual or suggestive themes or any subject matter considered disturbing, shall not be deemed appropriate. If necessary, RPR shall make final decisions as to what is appropriate for this exhibit and show.

Work must be the original creation of the applicant, not a collection for resale, but duplicates or prints of original work of the displaying artists will be acceptable. The size and number of pieces are dictated by the space measuring 10'x10' and the cost for a space is \$45. An exhibitor may purchase more than one space if desired.

Sales and Property Protection

Work may be sold during the event, however, must remain displayed and cannot be taken down until the event is over. Artwork may be numbered and identified and a price list can be left with the receptionist. Artists must provide their own means of displaying and mounting materials in the open space provided, and may bring a canopy or tent, provided it does not exceed the space allocation. An artist may display a biography.

Shared Booths

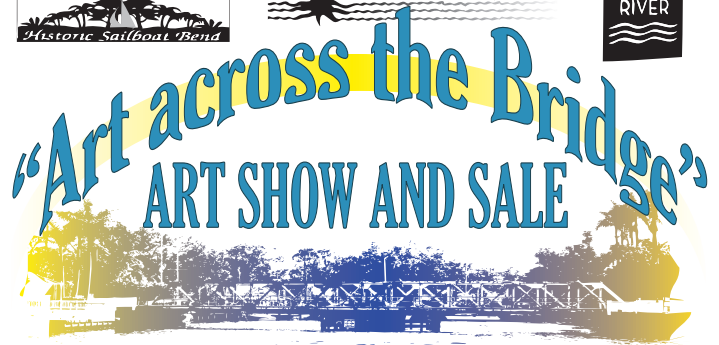
One booth space may be shared by two artists, but both artists' work must be juried into the show. Artists wishing to share a booth should submit only one application. Both artists must submit at least one or two photos representative of work to be displayed.

General Information

Check-in will be Saturday, October 15, 2011, from 8 AM until 10 AM. Pets are not allowed under any circumstances. Shirts are required and no smoking is allowed. RPR is not responsible for sales' results. Artists must supply all materials needed for their display. All displays must be designed to fit in the space reserved. Staking of any kind is not allowed. Awnings with stakes or awnings that exceed your allocated booth are not allowed. No flooring of any kind is allowed in the booth.

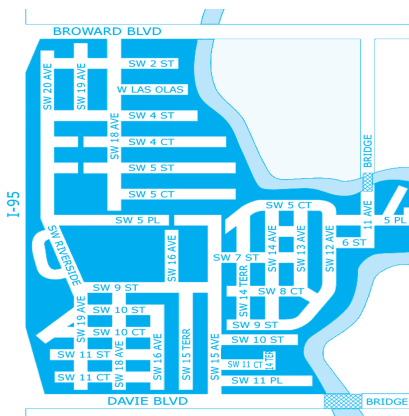
