The City now has Shot Spotter which allows the police to triangulate locations of gun shots. Increase in helicopter usage is due to an uptick in violent crime in the city.

Community Enhancement (Code Enforcement) Report

- Michael Jordon reported 209 total cases, 130 completed, 51 open and 28 violations. Michael agreed to work with the neighborhood Action Team to address loitering and possible drug dealing at the apartment on the north end of 15th Ave.
