Neighborhood Action Team(Police)

Officer Pekrol reported 4 incidents. 1) Fighting at apartments on 18th Ave. Fight ended when a gun was fired into the ground. 2) Prowler on 14th ave. painted Ring Camera at home being tented. Residents were not home but Ring alerted them. They remotely activated lights and called police. 3) Fighting at apartments on 20th Ave. One person stabbed. 4) Undercover officers had traffic altercation on Broward Blvd. Followed Car into neighborhood. Gun fight and car chase occurred. Police vehicle crashed. Suspect arrested the next day. Resident asked officers to address homeless person at the Dog Park

Community Enhancement (Code Enforcement)

Officer Jordan reported that their office is receiving more valid complaints now that anonymous complaints are no longer accepted; except in life threatening situations. Officer Jordan reported 584 cases with 326 of those initiated by himself. Bulk trash violations are being addressed much quicker. Questions regarding tree ordinance were raised. Simple rule to remember when removing trees or branches; if it is 4 inch diameter or larger you may need a permit.

Old Business

- Movie Night will restart October.
- Speed/Cut-through mitigation - Speed bumps will be going in on 15th Ave in the next few months.
- Stranahan Cafeteria update - Approval to build a New Cafeteria as appeased to retrofitting the old one.
- Grand Drive Park - City is removing old docks and addressing liability issues so the Park can be opened to the Public.

PPP - Public, Private Partnerships

Tom Lanigan raised the issue of PPP in regards to the "One Stop Shop" and other projects that are happening around the City. He encourages all residents to get informed and involved.
